Green Lake Table Tennis Timeline

- September 2021 (approximately) Kim Goldov started reaching out to me about bringing back weekend table tennis (post pandemic). I explained to Kim that we would no longer be running program outside operating hours at all our sites and that, if they wanted to hold table tennis outside operating hours, they would need to rent the facility.
- April 20, 2022 Barb Wade and Chris Easterday met with GLTTC in person at Densmore. Barb explained that we could not be bring back weekend table tennis in the same format we once ran it, explained all the reasons why and gave options how the group could do so themselves (rental, service agreement).
- May 4, 2022 Kim Goldof sent a proposal via email to restart weekend table tennis in the same format we used to hold it with GLTTC only paying for a building monitor.
- May 2022 Barb Wade responds reiterating the group's options.
- November 30, 2022 Barb Wade, Chris Easterday and Jacqueline Oaksford met with Kim Goldov, Tom Veatch and Shava Lawson from Seattle Parks Foundation, GLTTC's new fiscal sponsor. We again explained the reasons we cannot run the program as we once did and explained their options. We talked further about the possibility of a service agreement where GLTTC volunteer hours could count for public benefit (reduce rental costs).
- January 19, 2023 Kim Goldov sent a written response to the November meeting saying they were disappointed in this proposal, and they did not want to pursue a service agreement. They wanted to just pay for a rental attendant.
- April 5, 2023 Barb Wade, LaShawn Street and Chris Easterday met with Kim Goldov and Shava Lawson to discuss again how a service agreement might work.
- Fall 2023 GLCC staff find QR codes on the wall and discover GLTTC is sending players to their website and running an unauthorized league during our drop-in table tennis time. They removed the QR codes, but they come back.
- November 2, 2023 Barb Wade asks to meet with Kim Goldov about the QR codes and unauthorized league. Emails are exchanged for several months, and the group refuses to stop the league. Eventually, they do.
- February 2024 Barb Wade asks the group to stop using Green Lake CC's phone number and address as their own on their website.
- SPR asks them to cease using Green Lake CC's phone number and address on their website as if these are also GLTTC's phone number and address.
- July 19, 2023 Daisy Catague and Barb Wade held a listening session at Green Lake Community Center to hear from the table tennis community.
- August 31, 2023 Daisy Catague, Tia Scott and Barb Wade held a follow up meeting with Kim Goldov and Shava Lawson. We once again present their options (rental, service agreement)
- November 11, 2023 Desiree Tabares, Daisy Catague, Brian Judd, Tia Scott, and Barb Wade meet with Joseph Groshong and Susan MacMenamin of the City Legal Unit. Legal agrees that GLTTC should cease using Green Lake CC's phone number and address as their own and cease running unauthorized leagues during our drop-in program.
- November 27, 2023 Barb Wade sent Kim Goldov a draft service agreement outlining the parameters in which SPR would reduce rental costs for GLTTC by 50%.

- December 19, 2023 Kim Goldov responded to Barb Wade saying that the service agreement as written was not acceptable. He attached a revised service agreement removing all fees except the building monitor.
- February 5, 2024 Barb Wade replies to Kim Goldov and Shava Lawson letting them know that the parameters in the original service agreement are non-negotiable.
- June 2024 GLTTC requests a meeting with the Superintendent's office.
- July 11, 2024 Christopher Williams, Daisy Catague, Tia Scott, Barb Wade meet with Kim Goldov and six members of GLTTC.
